




The Ottawa Visitors Center is a must-visit spot for anyone taking a trip to the Starved Rock Country area. This informational hub, located at the start of this picturesque downtown district, is home to a wide array of visitors pamphlets, helpful staff and selection of great Ottawa-centric merchandise. While you're there, be sure to grab a copy of Ottawa's historic walking tour brochure. This guidebook will take you on a



stroll through the city's turn-of-thecentury Old Town - pointing out sites of historical and cultural significance as you meander along lush walkways, past boutique shops and unique restaurants.

While Ottawa may be known for its historic downtown, boutique shopping and delicious dining destinations - there are also some great choices for interacting with nature.

Luckily, you've found the right place for information about the great outdoors in Ottawa. There is something for experienced hikers and casual nature lovers alike. Ottawa is home to Buffalo Rock State Park and The Dayton Bluffs Preserve, two gorgeous natural areas that allow you to experience all the beauty Illinois has to offer.





uffalo Rock State Park is just one of the gorgeous natural areas that Ottawa has to offer. There is plenty to see and experience on site. Whether it's along the cliffs over the river or through the woodlands, the park is sure to satisfy any nature lover, whether you're an experienced hiker or just getting a breath of fresh air.

The trails of Buffalo Rock State Park, located at 1300 North 27th Road, provide visitors with the chance to take in some spectacular views of the Illinois River and surrounding area from atop its cliffs and bluffs. There are also plenty of opportunities to explore the area's trees, other plants, and wildlife, to truly immerse yourself in the natural beauty of Ottawa. The site also hosts a baseball diamond, shelter with vending machines, and the signature attractions of Buffalo Rock State Park.


Buffalo Rock is home to three American bison, which can be seen daily. The animals can be seen daily. These creatures, once native to the area, truly make the state park feel alive and historic.

The Effigy Tumuli are art sculptures built with the purpose of emulating the same kind that were built by Native Americans in the past. Buffalo Rock hosts five of these sculptures, a snake, frog, catfish, water strider, and turtle.

History is abundant near Buffalo Rock. The region around the park was once home to an enormous intertribal trading post, a significant piece of the land's indigenous history - documented in the early Joliet-Marquette expedition. Centuries later, Buffalo Rock was used as a sanatorium and vacation spot for the workers of the Chicago based Crane Company. In 1928 the company donated the property to the state and it eventually became the attraction it is today.

With natural beauty all around, bison peacefully grazing, and effigies on site, Buffalo Rock State Park allows visitors to gaze into the past, viewing the land as it once was.


Located at **2997 Illinois Rt. 71**, this natural area allows visitors to explore many unique areas that are on the preserve. The property is home to woodlands, grass fields, cascades, and the Fox River. With plenty of trails to choose from and the variety of natural areas at Dayton Bluffs, there is always something new to discover.

At the Dayton Bluffs Preserve, nature and history come alive around all those who visit. The Conservation Foundation readily recognizes that Indigenous people lived on the land and as stewards of it, had a vital relationship with the land that now makes up the preserve,

and areas outside of it as well. With Native American burial grounds on site, the area is both an important natural and archaeological one.







ALLEN PARK

400 COURTNEY STREET

Allen Park is a sprawling destination park located along the banks of the Illinois River on the south side of Ottawa. The park features over 20 acres of land, shelters, fishing spots and convenient boat slips. Upcoming park enhancements include a paved quarter-mile looped walking trail, gaming area for chess/checkers tables, a ping pong table, bag toss stations and new playground equipment. New native plantings and interpretive signage will be installed educating residents about the Illinois River, plants, and pollinators.

DAYTON BLUFF PRESERVE

2997 ILLINOIS ROUTE 71

Experience 100 acres of open prairie in the midst of restoration, the majesty and cool shade of 150 woodland acres, rugged ravines, glistening water cascades, the beautiful Fox River, sacred Native American burial mounds and the Daniels family pioneer cemetery.

EAST MAIN BOAT LAUNCH

FAR EAST END OF MAIN STREET East Main Boat Launch is a 10-acre area located at the far east end of Main Street along the Illinois River. The park contains a boat ramp, docks, fishing, and parking.

EAST SIDE PARK

712 YORK STREET

East Side Neighborhood Park is located on the northeast corner of York and Congress Streets. The park contains basketball courts, newly designed playground equipment in 2021 and a zip line.

FOX RIVER PARK

1025 ONTARIO STREET

Fox River Park is located on the east side. The park is over 15 acres with many amenities, including a water splash pad, a newly expanded 18 basket Disk Golf Course, boat ramps, and playground equipment.

GREEN STREET PARK

920 GREEN STREET

This neighborhood park features a practice baseball field, open to the public when not being used by a local team.

HOLLYWOOD PARK

833 DELEON STREET

Hollywood Neighborhood Park is located on the north side of town, at the corner of DeLeon and Mulberry Streets. This newly constructed park features playground equipment, shelter and electric power.



KIWANIS PARK

115 E. GLOVER STREET

Kiwanis Park is located south of the Illinois River on Route 23. The park contains playground equipment, shelters, and ample open spaces. The park also features a newly constructed free outdoor fitness court. The court has seven different areas to do exercises like lunges, core workouts, and agility. If you don't have a trainer or a group of people to workout with, there is an app called Fitness Court that has guided training on how to use the equipment located at the park.

LINCOLN-DOUGLAS PARK

600 E. NORRIS DRIVE

This multi-use community park is located north of Route 6. The park consists of a newly installed pool, four baseball fields, two softball diamonds, a soccer field, batting cages, playground equipment, and a new inclusive playground for kids of all abilities to enjoy.

PECK PARK

1510 STATE STREET

Peck Park is located on the south side, west of Route 23. It contains four softball diamonds, a baseball field, shelters, parking, playground equipment, and ample open spaces.

RIGDEN PARK

625 W. JACKSON STREET Ridgen Park is located west of downtown Ottawa on Lafayette Street. The park contains a baseball field, basketball courts, shelter, and playground equipment.

SKATE PARK

325 W. JACKSON STREETOttawa Skate Park is a specialized community park that provides skateboarding opportunities.

THORNTON PARK

1600 W. JACKSON STREET This recently renovated park features a splash pad and playground equipment with shady benches and picnic tables for lounging families to enjoy. The park also features newly refinished pickle ball, tennis and basketball courts.

TURNBERRY PARK

2832 TURNBERRY DRIVE Turnberry Park is a small neighborhood park at the northeast part of Ottawa. The park contains a shelter, playground equipment, and basketball court.

VARLAND PARK


310 E. MCKINLEY ROAD Varland Park is located on the south side of town, east of Route 23. The park contains two baseball fields and playground equipment.

101 W. LAFAYETTE STREET Located in downtown Ottawa, the park contains historical monuments including a Civil War Monument and the Lincoln-Douglas debates statues and fountain set in a beautiful plaza setting surrounded by beautiful flower gardens and tall, shady Maple trees.





brush with history public art program was developed to help revitalize Ottawa's downtown and create a cultural attraction for tourists and residents of the community. The program is sponsored by the Ottawa Visitors Center and overseen by a committee of citizens devoted to public arts. Made possible by a grant through the National Endowment for the Arts and vetted by the Chicago Art Institute, the Brush with History committee has been committed

to quality and excellence since the program's inception. Organized in 1993 the first mural became a reality in 2002. To date, ten murals have been completed. As of 2021, only nine murals remain.

These eclectic and larger than life murals focus on figures and events that shaped Ottawa's history including local industry, prominent citizens and wildlife.

FOX RIVER AQUEDUCT

This early engineering marvel carried waters of the Illinois & Michigan Canal over the Fox River. The Fox River Aqueduct is the largest aqueduct along the I&M Canal Corridor. Built in the 1840s by David Sanger & Sons Construction Co. of Ottawa, the aqueduct spans a length of 464 feet. Supported by seven towering piers constructed of Joliet limestone, the aqueduct was once considered the eighth wonder of the world.
